

# THINKING ABOUT AN MBA?

Missouri S&T offers an MBA degree customized for Missouri S&T undergraduate students. While the MBA can be tailored to complement a background in engineering, it is also open to students from all degree areas. You need senior standing in a current Missouri S&T degree program, qualifying GPA, and admission for dual enrollment.



## APPLICATION PROCESS

All applicants must submit three letters of reference, a resume, and statement of purpose. The GMAT may be waived with a GPA of 3.2 or better at Missouri S&T. ## THE 4+1 PROGRAM

This program offers the opportunity to complete a portion of the MBA coursework during your last year of undergraduate courses.

If your GPA  $\geq 3.0$ , you qualify for one semester; a GPA  $\geq 3.5$  qualifies for two semesters of dual enrollment.

When pursuing this option, you pay undergraduate fees while completing graduate coursework. This option is not only cheaper, but it allows you to complete your MBA coursework quicker than the standard MBA schedule!
